- **Fire Risk Assessment (FRA):**

  - Is the FRA current and regularly reviewed (e.g., annually, or upon any significant change to the property or occupancy)?

- Is the fire alarm system serviced professionally at least annually? Are certificates retained?
- Is there a clear fire alarm sound audible throughout the property?
- **Fire Doors:**
  - Are all necessary fire doors (e.g., FD30s or FD60s on escape routes, kitchens, and sometimes bedrooms) installed?
  - Do all fire doors have correct self-closing devices?
  - Are intumescent strips and cold smoke seals fitted to all fire doors and frames?
  - Are all fire doors free from damage (e.g., no gaps, swelling, holes) and operating correctly?
  - Are records of fire door inspections and maintenance kept?
- **Fire Extinguishers & Fire Blankets:**
  - Are appropriate types and numbers of fire extinguishers provided in designated locations (e.g., water, CO2, foam)?
  - Are fire extinguishers clearly visible, accessible, and correctly mounted?
  - Are fire extinguishers serviced annually by a competent person? Are certificates kept?
  - Is a fire blanket provided in all kitchens?
- **Fire Safety Information & Plans:**
  - Are clear notices displayed in prominent locations detailing fire safety procedures, escape routes, and actions to take in a fire?
  - Are tenants provided with written fire safety information at the start of their tenancy?

- Are all electrical installations, gas appliances, and heating systems regularly maintained and safe?

- Are adequate and appropriate waste storage and disposal facilities provided and regularly managed?
- Is there a system for managing tenant complaints and carrying out timely repairs?
- Do you have a system for managing tenant behaviour, particularly in relation to fire safety (e.g., not obstructing escape routes, proper use of appliances)?
